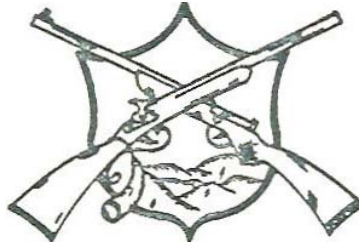

Building at Sizerville.

The "Port Allegany Reporter" says: Mr. C.E. Grover, of this village, has taken the contract for building a large hotel at Sizerville, for Messrs. Green & Westcott, of Westfield, Tioga county, Pa. The main Building will be 36 x 50 feet, three stories high, besides which there will be a wing 20 x 36 feet, two stories high. Work will be commenced immediately and pushed rapidly forward, as the contract calls for the completion of the building in sixty days.

HOTEL BURNED.

The Sizer Springs Hotel at Sizerville, was destroyed by fire Tuesday morning at 6 o'clock. The fire originated in the third story and rapidly enveloped the entire building. Mr. Kilbourn, the landlord, saved very little of the contents. No doubt the house will not be rebuilt. It's a bad blow to Sizerville.

J.E. Green, owner of the building, lost in building and contents \$4,000. Insurance \$800.

J.O. Kilbourn lost in furniture \$500, covered by insurance.
