

Rile Prosser, one time telegrapher at the Sizerville railroad tower and one of the best of our early photographers, wrote recently in the county papers of this rail wreck on the Buffalo Division at the mouth of Sizer Run, about 5 miles north of Emporium, in the winter of 1916.
